- 1.) Dead trees marked with an "X" are being removed. 23 trees have been taken down so far. Jeff Evans, Joe Rowell (Grandfather to Abby & Aiden Pearl), Hank Racette, Barb Maggy (Property Manager at Pearl PT), Robbie LaPierre and Elizabeth Pearl have been working each week to take them down. Our hope is to have them all removed prior to September 6th.

- 3.) The rusted sign poles are being painted and eventually straightened. 9 done but some will need a second coat.



Additional projects completed:

- 4 front flower beds have been weeded –**will still need mulch.**
- Front entrance & front yellow curb has been weeded.
- Nancy Thompson from Cook and Gardener has been to the school and offered to volunteer her time to landscape the front of the red brick wall. She has generously offered some free plants - hostas and daylilies. - Side stairs (near chemistry lab) have been weeded.
- 6 large bushes in front of the school have been trimmed.
- A basketball net was donated by the Kabeli family to Seton Catholic. It will be delivered and needs to be secured in concrete. **We need someone to help install this.**

- The sand in the parking lot is being shoveled out & temporarily being used to fill the potholes in the student parking lot.
- Joe Rowell has offered to volunteer with mowing the lawn as needed.
- Elizabeth Pearl hosted a Sunrise Yoga class which was held on July 9th, 2017. Donations were accepted to help with the landscaping and tree removal expense.
- A mason came to give an estimate on fixing the loose stone/ missing brick on the top of the red brick stone wall. Quote has not been received yet.
- Lowes came to the school to measure and give quotes on replacing the window blinds throughout the school. Quote has not been received yet.
- All dead branches have been moved to the burn pile. Jeff Evans is cutting up the huge tree that fell this winter into smaller sections so we can move it.
- The teacher's lounge is getting painted by the Trombley Family this week.
- Rusted railing was painted by cafeteria door. **Will need to add new reflective stickers.**

Ongoing goals:

- 1.) Continue to cut down dead trees.
- 2.) Clean up sand and weeds around the curb edges in parking lot.
- 3.) Get rid of stumps on property – **We need a stump grinder and volunteers to facilitate this.**
- 4.) Trim all bushes in the front of the school.
- 5.) Address landscaping/weeding in front of red brick wall.
- 6.) Install basketball net at school.
- 7.) Paint the green cafeteria wall; need more volunteers but remaining optimistic (Mrs. Bushey wanted her kitchen painted as well)
- 8.) Mrs. Pellerin would love her room painted (paint already avail)... again we just need more talented painters!
- 9.) Fix up middle courtyard into an area for middle school students to play after school.
